# MUNICIPAL DELCARATION OF EMERGENCY LIFTED IN NORTH MIDDLESEX

**MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH MIDDLESEX, July 28, 2021** - Mayor Brian Ropp, today announced that the Declaration of Emergency in the Municipality of North Middlesex has been terminated as of 1:25 pm on Wednesday, July 28, 2021. The Emergency Declaration was declared in response to the COVID-19 pandemic on March 17, 2020.

The Municipality of North Middlesex Emergency Control Group (ECG) determined that the controls afforded under the Emergency Declaration were no longer deemed necessary. "The end of the Declaration of Emergency doesn't mean an end to public health measures" Mayor Ropp explained. "Council is pleased with the efforts of our residents and business owners to help contain the spread of COVID-19 during the height of the pandemic".

Residents are reminded that all regulations through the Middlesex-London Health Unit (MLHU) and the Province of Ontario are still in effect. In addition, residents are encouraged to receive their COVID-19 vaccine which can be booked through the MLHU website (<https://www.healthunit.com/covid-19-vaccine>).
