Materials Accepted:

No Charge: E-Waste (Electronics) ONLY AT SPRING CLEAN UP, Tires, Brush, potted plants, leaves in paper bags. Owner is responsible to dump leaves out of plastic bags.

Appliances: Dehumidifiers, dishwashers, stoves, BBQ's, fridge, stoves, washer, dryer
 Metal material doors must be removed from appliances.

Note: Appliances containing refrigerants must have a certification tag attached stating that it has been drained of freon gas regardless of compressor being removed.

Renovation Material: Carpet, plywood, vinyl siding, metal doors, toilet, wall tile, insulation

Furniture: Couch, table, chair, steel bed rails

Materials Not Accepted: **HAZARDOUS MATERIALS**, used oil, paint, shingles, asphalt, drywall, animal waste, spoiled grain, tree stumps, HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE, batteries, plaster, fluorescent light bulbs.
