

NEWS RELEASE MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH MIDDLESEX RECEIVES HOUSING ACCELERATOR FUNDING

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE - FEBRUARY 27, 2025

NORTH MIDDLESEX, ONTARIO – The Municipality of North Middlesex is pleased to announce that we are a successful recipient of the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC's) Housing Accelerator Fund (HAF), Round 2. The \$1,898,943 received through the fund will complete the de-sludging works at the Parkhill lagoons.

The funding will remove barriers and support the timely implementation of housing initiatives, with funds tied to delivering results. This will happen through: initiatives aimed at increasing housing density in residential neighbourhoods; leveraging municipally owned lands to address housing shortages and enhance affordability; encouraging mixed-use development and greater densities; incentivizing the creation of affordable and climate resilient housing; encouraging the creation of additional residential units through a toolkit to facilitate planning and expedite the permitting process.

We are excited about the positive impact this funding will have on the growth and development of our community.
