



## **NEWS RELEASE MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH MIDDLESEX DECLARES SIGNIFICANT WEATHER EVENT**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – FEBRUARY 17<sup>TH</sup>, 2025**

**NORTH MIDDLESEX, ONTARIO** – The Municipality of North Middlesex has declared a Significant Weather Event in accordance with Ontario Regulation 239/02 under the Municipal Act. This declaration is due to heavy snowfalls and winds impacting the municipality, making road and sidewalk conditions hazardous.

This declaration does not mean that roads are closed; however, it advises residents that road maintenance efforts, including plowing, salting, and sanding, may take longer than usual due to the severity of the weather conditions. The Municipality's Public Works team is actively monitoring and responding to the situation to ensure public safety.

### **Residents are advised to:**

- Exercise extreme caution when traveling on roads and sidewalks.
- Avoid unnecessary travel during the storm and allow extra time if travel is essential.
- Be aware of potential delays in snow removal and road maintenance.
- Stay updated through official municipal channels and local weather reports.

The Municipality will issue further updates as conditions change. We appreciate the public's patience and cooperation during this time.
